Welcome to the Feed the Family Pantry, offering fresh produce and cleaning supplies.

We also offer an opportunity for neighbors to serve as Volunteers in three-hour shifts each weekend. Saturdays from 2-5 to prep and bag for distribution. Sundays from 11-4 to prep, bag, distribute and clean up -one shift on Saturdays and two on Sundays.

The Pantry is observing strict COVID – 19 protocols. Volunteers must wear masks and gloves at all times, complete volunteer training, sign a liability waiver and have a good sense of humor.

Cleaning supplies are collected every Saturday and can be dropped off at the Pantry between 12-5 in the boxes outside the doors at the loading dock.
